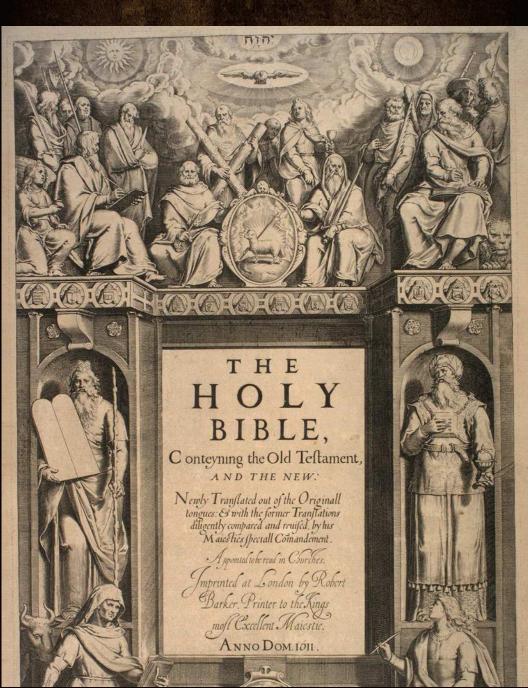
Do you know where you will be spending ETERNITY?

And if we accept Jesus as our Savior and believe He paid the price for our sin by dying on the cross and being raised from the dead, He will give us His righteousness so we can be free from sin and live forever with Him for all eternity.

God wants a family that He can spend eternity with. This is why God created us and this is why He sent His Son to pay the price to save us. He loves us and wants an eternal family that loves Him.

If you believe in Jesus, you will become a child of God and join His eternal family in Jesus.

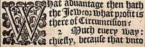
