slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, 30 boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents,

without understanding, untrustworthy, 31 unloving, unmerciful;

and although they know the ordinance of God, v. 19-20 32 that those who practice such things are worthy of death, they not only do the same, but also give hearty approval to those who practice them.

Chapter 2

The Impartiality of God

Rom 1:19,20,32 I Therefore you have no excuse, everyone of you who passes judgment, for in that which you judge another, you condemn yourself; for you who judge practice the same things.

And we know that the judgment of God rightly falls upon those who practice such things

The doers of the perfect law of liberty. There is only one man who was able to "do" the law flawlessly and that is 14 Jesus. We can be doers of the perfect law of liberty thru Jesus who fulfilled the law. Paul is building his case by stating that the one who follows the law perfectly, will be justified. What he hasn't said yet is that no one can be justified by the law because all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of 17 God, except one, Jesus Christ.

Or do you think lightly of the riches of His kindness and tolerance and patience, not knowing that the kindness of God leads you to repentance?

But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God,

who will render to each person ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS:

to those who by perseverance in doing good seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life;

but to those who are selfishly ambitious and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, wrath and indignation.

There will be tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek,

but glory and honor and peace to everyone who does good to the Jew first and also to the Greek. man cannot perform a good work apart from the Holy Spirit

For there is no partiality with God.

For all who have sinned without the Law will also perish without the Law, and all who have sinned under the Law will be judged by the Law; either way, man is judged a sinner without the blood of Jesus for it is not the hearers of the Law who are just

before God, but the doers of the Law will be justified.

For when Gentiles who do not have the Law do instinctively the things of the Law, these, not having the Law, are a law to themselves, in that they show the work of the Law written in their hearts, their conscience bearing witness and their thoughts alternately accusing or else defending them,

on the day when, according to my gospel, God will judge the secrets of men through Christ

Jesus. that is how I want to be judged, thru Jesus

The Jew Is Condemned by the Law But if you bear the name "Jew" and rely upon the Law and boast in God, the Spirit and know His will and approve the things that are essential, being instructed out of the Law, and are confident that you yourself are a guide to the blind, a light to those who are in darkness,

a corrector of the foolish, a teacher of the immature, having in the Law the embodiment of knowledge and of the truth,

you, therefore, who teach another, do you not teach yourself? You who preach that one shall not steal, do you steal?

You who say that one should not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples?

You who boast in the Law, through your breaking the Law, do you dishonor God? For "THE NAME OF GOD IS BLASPHEMED Among the Gentiles because of you," just

Wh<mark>e</mark>n your spirit is reborn and justified, it is in perfect unity with the Father. As you love Jesus and abide in Him, you will find yourself doing the works of the law without even knowing it. Your reborn spirit starts to change the soul into thinking and acting according to the Spirit. But the soul must be renewed and sanctified, therefore when the soul is in line with the spirit, it will accuse or condemn the wrong thinking g and defend the right thinking until the day when we will be glorified into His body and salvation will be complete. For indeed circumcision is of value if you practice the Law; but if you are a transgressor of the Law, your circumcision has become uncircumcision.

So if the uncircumcised man keeps the requirements of the Law, will not his uncircumcision be regarded as circumcision? And he who is physically uncircumcised, if he keeps the Law, will he not judge you who though having the letter of the Law and circumcision are a transgressor of the Law?

All the World Guilty

Then what advantage has the Jew? Or what is the benefit of circumcision?

Great in every respect. First of all, that they were entrusted with the oracles of God.

What then? If some did not believe, their unbelief will not nullify the faithfulness of God, will it?

May it never be! Rather, let God be found true, though every man be found a liar, as it is written,

> "THAT YOU MAY BE JUSTIFIED IN YOUR WORDS.

AND PREVAIL WHEN YOU ARE JUDGED." But if our unrighteousness demonstrates the righteousness of God, what shall we say? The God who inflicts wrath is not unrighteous, is He? (I am speaking in human terms.) May it never be! For otherwise, how will God judge the world? But if through my lie the truth of God abounded to His glory, why am I also still

being judged as a sinner? And why not say (as we are slanderously

reported and as some claim that we say), "Let us do evil that good may come"? Their condemnation is just.

What then? Are we better than they? Not at all; for we have already charged that both Jews the corrupted soul and Greeks are all under sin;

Chapter 5

Results of Justification

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

- through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.
- 3 And not only this, but we also exult in our tribulations, knowing that tribulation brings about perseverance;
- 4 and perseverance, proven character; and proven character, hope;
- 5 and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
- 6 For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.
- For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die.
- 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
- 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.
- For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.
- 11 And not only this, but we also exult in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.
- Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned—
- for until the Law sin was in the world, but sin is not imputed when there is no law.
- Nevertheless death reigned from Adam until Moses, even over those who had not sinned in the likeness of the offense of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come.
- 15 But the free gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many.
- The gift is not like that which came through the one who sinned; for on the one hand the judgment arose from one transgression resulting in condemnation, but on the other hand the free

- gift arose from many transgressions resulting in justification.
- 17 For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.
- 18 So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men.
- For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, even so through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous.
- The Law came in so that the transgression would increase; but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more,
- so that, as sin reigned in death, even so grace would reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Chapter 6

Believers Are Dead to Sin, Alive to God

- I What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin so that grace may increase?
- 2 May it never be! How shall we who died to sin still live in it?
- Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death?
- 4 Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.
- 5 For if we have become united with *Him* in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be in the likeness of His resurrection,
- 6 knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin;
- 7 for he who has died is freed from sin.
- 8 Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him,
- 9 knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, is never to die again; death no longer is master over Him.
- For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.
- Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus.
- Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its lusts,
- and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.
- 14 For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under law but under grace.
